What's (not) in Your Truck

With spring around the corner, now would be a good time to do some spring cleaning on your company truck or dump truck. HERE ARE A FEW REMINDERS:

1. Check your fire extinguisher. Good for one year after the date that is punched. Checked off every month and mounted. **We recently had an inspection violation for this!**
2. Foreman make sure you have eye wash on your truck
3. Check your first aid kit and update.
4. Make sure you have triangles for emergencies
5. Take this time to learn how to take pictures with your cell phone not when you are in an accident
6. Utility crews check your data sheets on trench boxes
7. All foreman make sure you have your SDS Booklets
8. Registration and insurance card with proper dates. Med Cards should be up to date. Don't forget the accident reports so we get the details of an incident.
9. Good time for a good house cleaning. Organize the back of truck with shelves
10. Labels on all containers and doors
11. No Smoking signs where necessary
12. Seatbelts in working order
13. Check for cracked windshields
14. Have minor body damage repaired
15. Check back-up alarms
16. Dump trucks check for broken side boards
