With spring around the corner, now would be a good time to do some spring cleaning on your company truck or dump truck. HERE ARE A FEW REMINDERS:

- 1. Check your fire extinguisher. Good for one year after the date that is punched. Checked off every month and mounted. We recently had an inspection violation for this!
- 2. Foreman make sure you have eye wash on your truck
- 3. Check your first aid kit and update.
- 4. Make sure you have triangles for emergencies
- 5. Take this time to learn how to take pictures with your cell phone not when you are in an accident
- 6. Utility crews check your data sheets on trench boxes
- 7. All foreman make sure you have your SDS Booklets
- 8. Registration and insurance card with proper dates. Med Cards should be up to date. Don't forget the accident reports so we get the details of an incident.
- 9. Good time for a good house cleaning. Organize the back of truck with shelves
- 10. Labels on all containers and doors
- 11. No Smoking signs where necessary
- 12. Seatbelts in working order
- 13. Check for cracked windshields
- 14. Have minor body damage repaired
- 15. Check back-up alarms
- 16. Dump trucks check for broken side boards
